Meeting Minutes Director's Meeting at Lamson Farm In Mont Vernon, NH. July 16, 2017

The dyno meter that we bought a gauge for will be on the field for tractors to see how strong they are. We will be taking donations to hitch to it. A motion was made to buy a granite bench not to exceed \$550 in honor of Matt Petz to be installed at the field in Dublin, N.H. next to Jerry Bunkers as long as it is acceptable to the field owner. We voted to give the Lamson Farm \$50.00 for the use of their great location. The meeting was followed by a picnic of hot dogs, hamburgers and several salads along with those great deviled eggs. All of the above were prepared by many an enjoyed by all. We then got on our tractors and went on a parade over some of the roughest roads in the state of New Hampshire. When we got back everyone had

a great time talking about what a fun day. The next Director's meeting will be held at Jim Wheeler's house in Milford, N.H. on November 12, 2017 at 10:00am.

The meeting adjourned at 11;25am.
