Meeting Minutes
Director's Meeting at Lamson Farm

July 15, 2018

Chuck Moore's term is up this year and he is running again. At today's meeting Will Anderson has stepped up to take the unexpired term of Steve Lingley which will be voted on at the fall banquet.

A discussion on the president's position took place to replace Jim. Mark Wells reminded the Board that the membership does not vote on the office holders only the Director's. The by-laws state at the first Directors meeting after the fall banquet membership meeting the full board will elect the officers. Ed Darowski a long time Chapter 8 member had a structure fire at this home. Chapter 18 had a fund raiser for him and gave him a check recently. He lives in Rehoboth, MA.

Will Anderson is taking the Chapter trailer to the Raitt Show in Elliot Maine. Next year's raffle pedal tractor will be ordered soon. The next Director's meeting will be at Kim Spaulding's in Pepperell on November 13, 2018 at 6:00pm. A motion to donate \$50 to Lamson Farm for the use of the place for our picnic was approved by a voice vote.

Gary Munsey a long time member of Chapter 18 has volunteered to take over the newsletter and webmaster job. Gary did this job years ago.

The meeting adjourned at 11:43am followed by our meal of hot dogs, hamburgers, salads, desserts and enjoyed by all. Then some of the fellows got on their tractors and went on a ride around rural New Hampshire on vintage IH tractors. It doesn't get any better than that!
